**Supervisor's Report:**

- The building contract with CNR Construction is now in place. Supervisor Brown thanked Councilman Hinderer for his help in drafting the contract. The deposit has been made on the building also. Additional bids will be taken for the inside work at a later date. The foundation and ground work will be done by the town highway with a concrete consultant will be supervising.
- Supervisor Brown would like the board to approve a resolution to pay the Animal Control Officer on a monthly salary as opposed to an hourly rate. The Board was in agreement with this. The town clerk will draft a resolution for next month's meeting.
- Supervisor Brown reviewed an email he had sent to the CCIDA concerning the Chautauqua County Economic Development Plan. Supervisor Brown wanted to remind the CCIDA not to overlook the small towns and rural areas.
- Supervisor Brown reported that he attended a seminar at Southern Tier West on grants. Unfortunately, nothing pertained to our town.

**Old Business:**

- The bank account at Catt. Co. bank has been closed and monies deposited to the general fund.
- The court bank account for Bruce Scolton has also been closed and money deposited to the general fund.

**New Business:**

- A new table is needed for the board meetings. Supervisor Brown has found one on amazon. The board decided to table the mater for now until a better quality table can be found.
